Since 1933, Baron Philippe de Rothschild SA, located at Pauillac in the Médoc, has been motivated by a constant ambition: to make the world's finest wines, each in its own category, whether the châteaux wines for which it is responsible - the renowned Château Mouton Rothschild, a First Growth, and its distinguished lieutenants, Château Clerc Milon and Château d'Armailhac.

St Estèphe is the northernmost of the most important communes of the Médoc, bordering Pauillac on its southernmost border, with only a gully and stream separating it from Chateau Lafite Rothschild. The wines can appear austere in youth, but the best typically display good depth of colour, pronounced acidity and tannins in youth, and are exceptionally long-lived. At their best, they are the equal of almost any Bordeaux.

The aristocrat of the Médoc boasts 75 percent of the region's First Growths, with Grand Cru Classés representing 84 percent of production. Its wines are characterized by both their power and finesse. They deliver firmly structured wines that age with exceptional grace. The wines typically express dusty cocoa tannins and a rich aromatic profile of blackcurrant, sweet cigar-box, lead pencil, cedar, violet, rose, iris and lilac.

If Pauillac is the bastion of 'traditional' Red Bordeaux, Margaux represents its other facet in producing wines that are some of the region's most sensual, alluring, perfumed and elegant of all the Médoc communes. Many consider them to be the most "feminine" wines of the Médoc.

Graves & Entre-Deux-Mers

The region which first established Bordeaux's reputation, Graves wines were exported to England as early as the 12th century. The name is derived from 'gravel' and the best soils are gravel-rich, mixed with sand and occasionally clay. Drainage is so good here, that wine collectors look to Graves when the Médoc has had a wet year, knowing that Graves will still have made a good wine.

The Médoc is arguably the most famous red wine district in the world, home to many of the greatest and most renowned names of Bordeaux. Stretching north-west from the city of Bordeaux with the Gironde estuary to the east, the vineyards extend up to eight miles from the river and run for about 50 miles northwards. It is traditionally said that the best vines of the Médoc are those that grow within sight of the Gironde.

St Emilion

First officially classified in 1954, St Emilion is one of Bordeaux's largest winemaking appellations, producing more wine than Listrac, Moulis, St Estèphe, Pauillac, St Julien and Margaux combined. Many of the region's finest vineyards can be found atop the steep limestone slopes of the village itself, although a fledgling band of garagiste producers are eschewing terroir to make small-batch, deeply-concentrated wines from their homes.

Established in Mercurey, the heart of the Burgundian Côte Chalonnaise, Maison Antonin Rodet have cultivated wines since 1875. Cultivating a 90-hectare vineyard over the Mercurey appellation, they also produce wines from the villages of Maranges, Santenay and over the Hautes-Côtes de Beaune area. In this exceptional environment, bordered with two emblematic castles in Rully and Mercey together with the Domaine de la Bressande, the unique terroirs of Southern Burgundy express themselves marvellously. Of noble character and fully expressive after traditional winemaking, the Antonin Rodet wines reflect their origins with great purity.

Anne-Laure Hernette, the “vinicultrice” & Ambassador of Maison Antonin Rodet. Anne-Laure is in charge of the vinification, the ageing and the blending of her wines. She works hand-in-hand with Georges Piazzon, the Châteaux vineyard managers and their teams to decide on the crop management. She guarantees the quality to the House supplies. She creates the blends and guarantees the consistency of quality and style.

Domaine Vincent Lumpp

Domaine Vincent Lumpp is situated in the hamlet of Poncey, in the south of the Givry appellation, in the heart of the Côte Chalonnaise. Vincent Lumpp runs the domaine with the help of his son, Baptiste. They combine traditional and progressive techniques in order to ensure the highest quality possible and allow the wines to reflect the true essence of their Burgundy terroir. The Domaine uses sustainable methods to cultivate its 9 hectares of vines, which are classified as follows: - GIVRY Premier Cru white, 1 hectare of Chardonnay: 'Le Vigron' and 'La Grande Berge'. GIVRY Villages Premier Cru red, 8 hectares of Pinot Noir: 'Crémillons', 'La Grande Berge', 'Le Vigron', 'Clos du Cras Long' and 'Clos Saint-Paul'.

The work in the winery is carried out using the same approach as in the vineyards: as simply as possible in order to let the terroir reflect its own personality. The wines are aged in French oak barrels for approximately 12 months before being sealed with high-quality Spanish corks in order to guarantee optimum conservation conditions.

Frederic Magnien

Frédéric Magnien is widely regarded as one of the shrewdest and sharpest young winemakers working in the Côte d'Or today. His father Michel Magnien is a well-respected vigneron who produces wine in his own right, as well as being responsible for the vineyard management of Maison Louis Latour. Frédéric Magnien is the fifth generation of his family in Morey-St-Denis. Having worked with his father after wine school, and then travelled to work with Pinot producers in California and Australia, Frédéric rejoined his father in 1993 and two years later created his own négociant label, which has proved one of the recent success stories in Burgundy.




Pascal Jolivet

Dopff & Irion

Since 1945, Dopff & Irion have produced wines from a 27-hectares vineyard within the district of Riquewihr, as well as the 5 hectares belonging to Clos Château d'Isenbourg (at Rouffach). This is a fairly large size, in light of the fragmentation of the properties in Alsace (60% of farmers own surface areas, representing less than one hectare). The surname of the Dopff family has always been linked to the district of Riquewihr, officially recognized as one of the most beautiful villages in France. After World War II, René Dopff and the widow Irion, two prestigious names of the vine-growing sector in Riquewihr, joined forces, thereby initiating the start to Dopff & Irion. One of their first decisions was that of acquiring the historic castle of Riquewihr (built in 1549). René Dopff was an emblematic and prestigious producer, who influenced the Alsace wine industry during most of his life. Jean-François Kueny, has been Winemaker since 1998, and has won many accolades for his wines including Best French Wine Producer at the IWSC 2002 and The Robert Mondavi Winemaker of the year Trophy.





The Gaja winery has delivered pioneering work in wine production for five generations and it is still on top of the list in the international wine world of Wine Spectator, Suckling, Decanter and others. Gaja's story began in 1859, when Giovanni Gaja started producing Barbaresco. Since then, five generations of Gajas have been producing wines in Piedmont's Langhe hills, Giovanni's son, Angelo (grandfather of today's Angelo Gaja), was blessed with ambition and vision. Clotilde Rey, whom he married in 1905, inspired him to establish the tradition to which the Gajas have adhered ever since total dedication to uncompromising quality.

Angelo Gaja, joined the Winery in 1961 and combined his respect for the traditions of the Langhe with bold innovations in the vineyards and the cellars. Today, Angelo along with his family, have been continuing a family tradition that has never stopped since 1859. The Gaja Winery owns 96ha (240 acres) of vineyards in the Barbaresco district - Barbaresco and Treiso - and the Barolo district - Serralunga d'Alba and La Morra. In 1994, Gaja acquired their first wine estate in Tuscany, Pieve Santa Restituta in Montalcino (27ha) of vineyards and Ca' Marcanda, located in the Bolgheri district in the municipality of Castagneto Carducci. The title "Godfather of Italian Wines" is very common when you Google the word "Gaja".

Catena Appellations

In Burgundy, the Vins de Village are wines that come from grapes grown in the territory of certain villages which give their name to the appellation, such as Volnay, Pommard, Meursault or Vosne-Romanée. In a similar manner, the rural towns of Lunlunta, Vista Flores, San Carlos, Tupungato, Agrelo and La Consulta lend their names to the beautiful historic vineyards that surround them. In France, the Village vineyards are small, and often owned by siblings and cousins within the same family. This is due to the Napoleonic code, which establishes that at a person's death his or her land is divided equally among his or her heirs. As a Latin country, Argentina shares the Napoleonic code, and over half of the vineyards in Mendoza are less than four hectares in size and owned by multiple family members. The country life of the Mendoza Villages is ruled by the Saturday asado/barbecue with friends and family, by the daily afternoon siesta and by the Sunday church visit and the occasional wedding or baptism. The flavors of our Catena Appellation "Village" wines express the diversity of terroir and the historic farming customs of these local families.
