Welcome to our 2022 Portfolio!



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LOUIS JADOT



From the tip of Chablis to the toe of Beaujolais, from regional, village, 1er Cru and Grand Cru wines Louis Jadot produces Burgundy and nothing but Burgundy. The familiar Bacchus head label has become the reliable stamp of quality and consistency from what can often be a confusing region.

Louis Henry Denis Jadot founded the business in 1859. His vision was to build a business with a high quality reputation. One of his key aims, as well as to make top wines, was to build a significant vineyard base. This vision remains core to the business today.

Over time, prestigious acquisitions have included Beaune Clos des Ursules, Chevalier Montrachet Les Demoiselles, the Clair Dau Estate with vineyards in Bonnes Mares, Chambertin Clos de Beze, Musigny and Gevrey Chambertin Clos St Jacques. Plus the picturesque Santenay Clos de Malte and Premier Cru holdings in Puligny Montrachet, Savigny Les Beaune, Pernand Vergelesses and Corton Grand Cru to name but a few.

Today the business is headed up by Pierre Henry Gagey, son of Andre Gagey, who was entrusted with the management of Louis Jadot in 1962 by Madame Jadot following the tragic death of her son, Louis Auguste Jadot. Pierre Henry is a passionate believer in terroir, allowing the wines to present the very essence of Burgundy.

CHÂTEAU DES JACQUES

Château des Jacques' motto is 'a great wine is a living wine', and indeed this property's wines are some of the most long-lived in the entire Beaujolais region.

The historic Château des Jacques estate, located in the village of Romanèche-Thorins in the Moulin-à-Vent appellation, is widely recognized as the most prestigious estate in Beaujolais. It was purchased by Louis Jadot in 1996, at which time Maison Louis Jadot became the first Burgundy house to own a major Beaujolais vineyard. In 2001, Louis Jadot bought another well-located vineyard in Morgon. In 2008, both vineyards, which were under the same management, were regrouped under one identity: the Château des Jacques Estates.

ST EMILION

First officially classified in 1954, St Emilion is one of Bordeaux's largest winemaking appellations, producing more wine than Lustrac, Moulis, St Estèphe, Pauillac, St Julien and Margaux combined. Many of the region's finest vineyards can be found atop the steep limestone slopes of the village itself, although a fledgling band of garagiste producers are eschewing terroir to make small-batch, deeply-concentrated wines from their homes.

ST. ESTÈPHE



St Estèphe is the northernmost of the most important communes of the Médoc, bordering Pauillac on its southernmost border, with only a gully and stream separating it from Château Lafite Rothschild. The wines can appear austere in youth, but the best typically display good depth of colour, pronounced acidity and tannins in youth, and are exceptionally long-lived. At their best, they are the equal of almost any Bordeaux.

PAULLIAC

The aristocrat of the Médoc boasts 75 percent of the region's First Growths, with Grand Cru Classés representing 84 percent of production. Its wines are characterized by both their power and finesse. They deliver firmly structured wines that age with exceptional grace. The wines typically express dusty cocoa tannins and a rich aromatic profile of blackcurrant, sweet cigar-box, lead pencil, cedar, violet, rose, iris and lilac.

MÉDOC

The Médoc is arguably the most famous red wine district in the world, home to many of the greatest and most renowned names of Bordeaux. Stretching north-west from the city of Bordeaux with the Gironde estuary to the east, the vineyards extend up to eight miles from the river and run for about 50 miles northwards. It is traditionally said that the best vines of the Médoc are those that grow within sight of the Gironde.

PASCAL JOLIVET



The Jolivet family entered the wine business in 1926. However, it was in 1990 that Pascal Jolivet built a brand new winery to facilitate the development and production of his wines. Inspired by the Champenois facilities that he knew so well the cellar in Sancerre is equipped with temperature controlled stainless steel tanks and other state of the art facilities. In 1993 inspired by Jacques Jolivet purchased 6 hectares of vineyards. In 1995 6 hectares of vines were purchased in Pouilly Fumé. Wine Spectator has twice ranked Pascal Jolivets Sancerre among the best 100 wines of the year.

DOPFF & IRION

From one generation to the next, the DOPFF and IRION families, whose origins date back to the 16th century, have made the most out of their heritage: the vineyard and Riquewihr castle. At present, the historic edifice is the headquarters of Maison Dopff & Irion. Created in 1945, this company elaborates wine from a 27-hectare vineyard within the district of Riquewihr, as well as the 5 hectares, belonging to Clos Château d'Isenbourg. This is a fairly large size, in light of the fragmentation of the properties in Alsace (60% of farmers own surface areas, representing less than one hectare) The surname of the Dopff family has always been linked to the district of Riquewihr, officially recognized as one of the most beautiful villages in France. After World War II, René Dopff and the widow Irion, two prestigious names of the vine-growing sector in Riquewihr, joined forces, thereby initiating the start to Dopff & Irion. One of their first decisions was that of acquiring the historic castle of Riquewihr. René Dopff was an emblematic and prestigious producer, who influenced the Alsace wine industry during most of his life. Since the foundation of the winery, the harvest had always been done by hand and the wines are crafted using the utmost care. The winery is certified HVE 3 and Bee-friendly.

Domaine Tariquet, located in Gascony in the South West of France, has been owned by the Grassa family since 1912. As wine-grower, all the wines and Bas-Armagnacs are produced exclusively from grapes grown on the family's vineyards. From the vines to the bottling, the Grassa family master every step of the production process, preserving the grapes' freshness and aromatic potential. The Grassa family have already been sustainably managing their vineyards for over 20 years. Armagnac is Europe's oldest eau-de-vie, over 700 years of history. High quality white wines are distilled. The ageing and the blending fulfill a style of elegant and delicate eaux-de-vie close to the original fruit. After fermentation, the wines are distilled at the estate in November and December, to produce the Bas-Armagnacs. The colour of the Domaine Tariquet Bas-Armagnacs comes uniquely from the ageing in barrels. The naturally light tint is due to the alchemy between the delicately toasted oak and the eaux-de-vie, thus truly respecting their natural color.

As 'propriétaire-récoltant' (wine grower), all the Bas-Armagnacs are made exclusively from the grapes harvested from the family-owned estate's vineyards. The nobility of the eaux-de-vie is based on the quality of the distilled wines, hence the meticulous care given to the cultivation of the vines. The wines from the September harvest are distilled in November and December. The distillation takes place at the estate. It is done in authentic armagnac copper alambics, grape variety by grape variety, using the traditional continuous distillation process. These traditional copper alambics are heated by wood fire, giving a second lease of life to the acacia vine stakes. Then, quietly safeguarded by the estate's hundred-year-old cellars, the eaux-de-vie are aged separately for the first years in new barrels or 'pièces' as they are locally called. The Grassa family prefers to use lightly toasted barrels made from the French timber forests renowned for their fine grain. The colour of Domaine Tariquet's Bas-Armagnacs comes exclusively from the ageing in these barrels. The light tint results from the alchemy between the delicately toasted oak and the eau-de-vie, truly respecting their natural colour.

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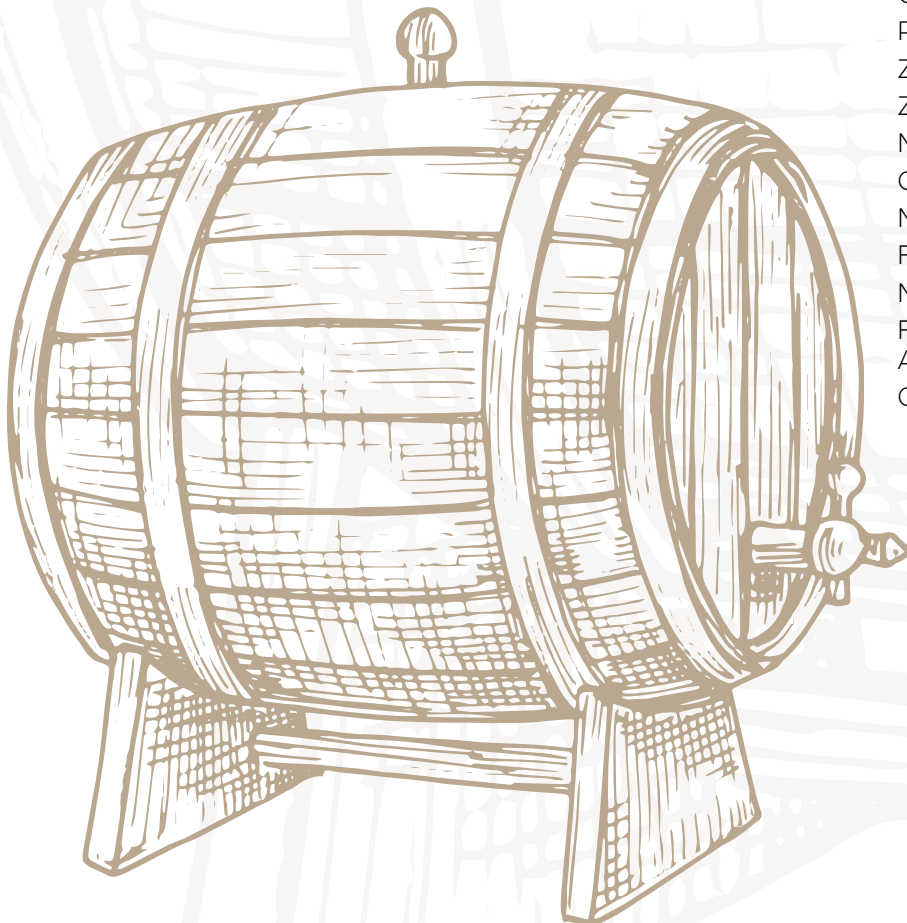

GAJA

The Gaja winery has delivered pioneering work in wine production for five generations and it is still on top of the list in the international wine world of Wine Spectator, Suckling, Decanter and others. Gaja's story began in 1859, when Giovanni Gaja started producing Barbaresco. Since then, five generations of Gajas have been producing wines in Piedmont's Langhe hills, Giovanni's son, Angelo (grandfather of today's Angelo Gaja), was blessed with ambition and vision. Clotilde Rey, whom he married in 1905, inspired him to establish the tradition to which the Gajas have adhered ever since total dedication to uncompromising quality. Angelo Gaja, joined the Winery in 1961 and combined his respect for the traditions of the Langhe with bold innovations in the vineyards and the cellars. Today, Angelo along with his family, have been continuing a family tradition that has never stopped since 1859. The Gaja Winery owns 96ha (240 acres) of vineyards in the Barbaresco district - Barbaresco and Treiso - and the Barolo district - Serralunga d'Alba and La Morra. In 1994, Gaja acquired their first wine estate in Tuscany, Pieve Santa Restituta in Montalcino (27ha) of vineyards and Ca' Marcanda, located in the Bolgheri district in the municipality of Castagneto Carducci. The title "Godfather of Italian Wines" is very common when you Google the word "Gaja".

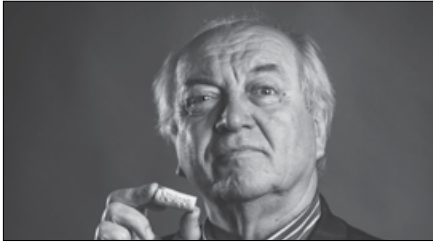

The Appassimento method is the same method used for the Amarone wines. In this case, this Appassimento from Missetti comes from southern Italy and is made from other grapes. Yet there are a number of comparisons to be discovered in its taste. The scent is very rich, you smell a lot of dark fruit and tones of roasted coffee. 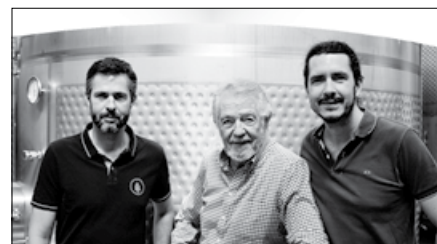

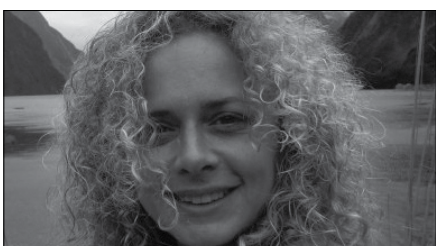

CATENA APPELLATIONS

In Burgundy, the Vins de Village are wines that come from grapes grown in the territory of certain villages which give their name to the appellation, such as Volnay, Pommard, Meursault or Vosne-Romanée. In a similar manner, the rural towns of Lunlunta, Vista Flores, San Carlos, Tupungato, Agrelo and La Consulta lend their names to the beautiful historic vineyards that surround them. In France, the Village vineyards are small, and often owned by siblings and cousins within the same family. This is due to the Napoleonic code, which establishes that at a person's death his or her land is divided equally among his or her heirs. As a Latin country, Argentina shares the Napoleonic code, and over half of the vineyards in Mendoza are less than four hectares in size and owned by multiple family members. The country life of the Mendoza Villages is ruled by the Saturday asado/barbecue with friends and family, by the daily afternoon siesta and by the Sunday church visit and the occasional wedding or baptism. The flavors of our Catena Appellation "Village" wines express the diversity of terroir and the historic farming customs of these local families.

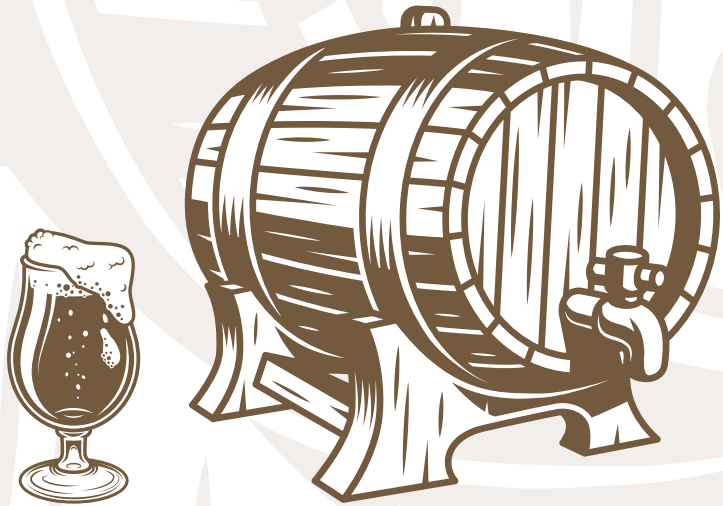
