Prestigious vineyard holdings include Beaune Clos des Ursules, Chevalier-Montrachet Les Demoiselles, and historic sites in Bonnes Mares, Chambertin Clos de Bèze, and Musigny, among others. Under the leadership of Pierre-Henry Gagey, the winery remains dedicated to expressing the essence of Burgundy's unique terroirs through wines of balance, elegance, and authenticity.

Château des Jacques' motto is 'a great wine is a living wine', and indeed this property's wines are some of the most long-lived in the entire Beaujolais region. The historic Château des Jacques estate, located in the village of Romanèche-Thorins in the Moulin-à-Vent appellation, is widely recognized as the most prestigious estate in Beaujolais. It was purchased by Louis Jadot in 1996, at which time Maison Louis Jadot became the first Burgundy house to own a major Beaujolais vineyard. In 2001, Louis Jadot bought another well-located vineyard in Morgon. In 2008, both vineyards, which were under the same management, were regrouped under one identity: the Château des Jacques Estates.

St Emilion

First classified in 1954, St Emilion is one of Bordeaux’s largest winemaking appellations, producing more wine than Listrac, Moulis, St Estèphe, Pauillac, St Julien, and Margaux combined. The region’s top vineyards often occupy the steep limestone slopes surrounding the village, while a growing group of garagiste producers focuses on crafting small-batch, intensely concentrated wines from their homes.

St Estèphe

St Estèphe is the northernmost of the most important communes of the Médoc, bordering Pauillac on its southernmost border, with only a gully and stream separating it from Château Lafite Rothschild. The wines can appear austere in youth, but the best typically display good depth of colour, pronounced acidity and tannins in youth, and are exceptionally long-lived. At their best, they are the equal of almost any Bordeaux.

Catena Appellations

In Burgundy, *Vins de Village* are wines made from grapes grown in specific village territories, such as Volnay, Pommard, Meursault, or Vosne-Romanée, which give their names to the appellation. Similarly, in Argentina, towns like Lunlunta, Vista Flores, San Carlos, Tupungato, Agrelo, and La Consulta are home to historic vineyards named after these villages.

In both France and Argentina, these village vineyards are often small and owned by families, with land divided among heirs according to the Napoleonic Code. In Mendoza, over half of the vineyards are under four hectares, often shared by multiple family members.

Mendoza's rural life revolves around traditions such as the Saturday *asado* (barbecue), afternoon siestas, Sunday church visits, and occasional celebrations like weddings and baptisms. These customs are reflected in the Catena Appellation "*Village*" wines, which express the diverse terroir and farming traditions of these towns, capturing the essence of Mendoza's rural life in every bottle.

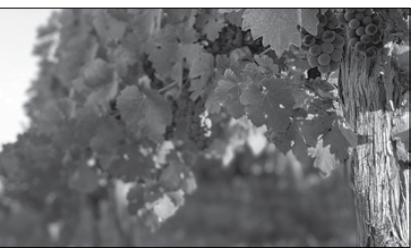
